Photos are organized by week and day. You may download web-quality images for personal use for free by right clicking on the image and hitting "save image as."

Here's what you can expect.

We understand that these photos are your only window into your child's camp experience while they are here, and we take that responsibility seriously. We do our best to capture the spirit of summer at CYO Camp Rancho Framasa

We upload images to our galleries 1-2 times per day.

Our first upload is usually late morning or early afternoon. Often, we upload a second time between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Due to weather, or other changes in the schedule, we may upload at slightly different times.

There is no maximum or minimum number of images that may appear in a gallery

We take as many photos as we can each day. Due to the busy nature of camp and only having one person to take photos, some days we have more than others.

We can only guarantee that your child will appear in your child's group picture.

Our objective is to best capture the spirit of a week at camp. Due to the varying nature of each camp day, as well as the number of campers we serve during the week, we cannot guarantee your child's appearance in photos outside of your child's group photo. Group photos are taken when all campers are present and are uploaded when all photos are complete. For most, group photos are taken on Sunday afternoon after check-in. However, when a camper arrives late, we take their group photo later in the week.

There are far fewer photos to upload on days when we have inclement weather.

Unfortunately, we can't control the weather. On days when campers must spend considerable time inside their cabins or the dining hall due to weather, we won't be able to take as many pictures.

We capture a wide range of emotions. Don't worry if your camper isn't smiling in one picture.

We do our best to capture the range of emotions experienced by campers throughout the week. From the joyful faces at check-in, to the tears at closing campfire. Sometimes this means your child won't be smiling in photos as they may be praying in chapel or concentrating on learning a new skill. Sometimes we catch a transitional moment as campers move from talking to their friends, to checking out the gaga pit. Just because your child isn't smiling in a photo does not mean your child is unhappy or upset. If your child is upset or unhappy over an extended period, you'll hear from us.

We can't fulfill photo requests

We don't have the capacity to fulfill specific photo requests while maintaining our commitment to capturing the spirit of the camp experience.
