

Dear CYO Camp Families.

Thank you for choosing CYO Camp and your continued interest and support.

This is an important message regarding the Coronavirus and our response as a camp.

Our priority is the safety of all our campers, participants, and staff. Therefore, following the recommendations of state authorities and the Archdioceses of Indianapolis, we are cancelling all programs through Friday, May 1, including “Women’s Only Weekend” Further cancellations will depend upon state and church recommendations.

**Summer Camp Registration and Hiring:**

For this summer, all summer camp registrations are still open at this time. Please reserve your spot for your children at camp. We will continue to monitor the coronavirus situation during April and May prior to the start of our summer camp programs. During this time, we will also develop a plan for all of our summer camp programs based on the recommendations of state officials, the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, and our camp board. If we are unable to hold summer camp, full refunds will be given.

We will continue with hiring for summer camp counseling staff, camp nurses, and food service staff. All interviews will be phone interviews.

We are hopeful that the coronavirus will recede long before our first summer camp, starting May 31 and as of today, we expect to be open, providing our campers with fresh air, plenty of space and a unique traditional summer camp experience as we have for many years.

Please note we have not had any cases of the coronavirus at camp and we are taking precautions with our current staff, programming, and cleaning procedures to prevent any occurrence.

Let's pray together for a speedy resolution to this situation. We hope to see you this summer! Let us know if we can be of help in any way.
