

Check-in

Steps to a smooth and wonderful check-in at CYO Camp!

TRADITIONAL, EXPLORE, RANCH HANDS, MUSTANG, SASSAFRAS, JUNIOR COUNSELOR, ADULT RECREATION CAMP

1. Arrive at 2pm (eastern)
2. Park in the parent parking lot.
3. Camp staff will direct you to the pavilion or your camper's cabin.
4. In the cabin... Your child's camp counselor will greet you. They will help your camper choose a bed and help you get them settled. You will say good-bye at your child's cabin.
5. You may want to stop back in the pavilion for popcorn and water or to check out items at our camp store before heading out. There are also staff in the pavilion to answer any last-minute questions.

ADVENTURE CAMP

1. Arrive at 2pm (eastern).
2. Park in the parent parking lot.
3. Camp staff will direct you to the Adventure Outpost.
4. You will say good-bye at the Adventure Outpost.
5. You may want to cross the road for popcorn and water or to check out items at our camp store before heading out. There are also staff in the pavilion to answer any last-minute questions.

JUNIOR COUNSELOR

1. Arrive at 11am (eastern).
2. Park in the office parking lot.
3. Meet camp staff at the main office with luggage and meds in hand.
4. You will say good-bye at the office.

Check-in includes:

Each camper will be asked COVID-19 and other health screening questions AND have their temperature taken.

Please note:

- Campers who have experienced an injury or illness prior to camp that would affect participation (i.e., fevers, breaks, fractures, strains, tears, sprains, rashes) must be assessed by the Assistant Camp Director to attend camp. This assessment should occur prior to check-in. Contact Lauren at lauren@campranchoframasa.org or 1-812-988-2839, x125; she will help determine if camp is a good fit for your child considering their injury or illness. If she determines that the camper cannot attend camp, a credit will be issued for a future camp session. **Campers who are wearing a splint, a brace or a cast will not be able to attend camp.**
- Each camper will be assessed for head lice upon arrival to camp. If live lice are present, campers will not be permitted to stay at camp. Credits for a future session of camp will be given.
- Campers who are bringing medication to camp will turn in their medication and provide any necessary information. Medication should be in its original container and in a plastic bag labeled with your child's name. Also, if your child takes an over-the-counter medication such as Claritin ON A REGULAR BASIS, please bring enough doses for the week, also in the original container and labeled plastic bag.

Bringing Your Child to Camp

When you bring your child to camp:

- Wear comfortable or hiking shoes. Some of the cabins are a hike from the registration area.
- Be prepared to carry your camper's luggage to his/her cabin. The cabins that are far away from the registration area will have luggage delivered by the camp truck.
- Please note that camp policy prevents any camper from saving a bed for a friend. In our efforts to be fair and inclusive we find saving beds can be counterproductive to making new friends and immediately sets children apart rather than building community. Please note that bunks are pre-assigned for this reason. Thank you for your patience and compliance with this policy.
- Please do not bring your pets to camp even on a leash. A staff member will ask you to leave with your pet or to close the pet in your vehicle. Summer days are hot and this may not be convenient for you and unsafe for your pet. Pets are not allowed on camp property. If you have a service dog please phone 812-988-2839, x122, to inform us that your dog will be accompanying you on camp property.

Last, but not least:

- Campers must be present for check-in.
- We are not able to check campers in early.
- For the safety of your child, we believe in the necessity of searching ALL luggage. Your child's counselor will check luggage. Please help us in this effort by assisting your child as they pack for camp. packing and unpacking lists can be found here: [Packing for Camp!](#)
- **Arriving Late?** Please call and leave a message with Mae, Camp Registrar, at ext. 122 if you will be arriving after check-in hours. Late check-in is allowed on check-in day until 7:00pm. If you are going to be later than 7:00pm please bring your child, no earlier than 9:30am the next day.

Check-out

ID Required

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TRADITIONAL, EXPLORE, RANCH HANDS, MUSTANG, SASSAFRAS, JUNIOR COUNSELOR, ADULT RECREATION CAMP AND JUNIOR COUNSELOR

1. Arrive at 2pm (eastern)
2. Park in the parent parking lot.
3. Cross the road to the pavilion. Your camper and Camp Staff will meet you there just after 2pm. Campers and staff are at Mass until just before 2pm.
4. Sign out camper---show ID.
5. Pick up unused medication.
6. Check **inside** your child's bags and the lost and found area to make sure you have everything.
7. Enjoy some free popcorn.
8. You may want to check out items at our camp store before heading out.

Lost and Found

Staff will assist campers with their belongings, but it is ultimately the parents' responsibility to make sure a child has all of his or her things. Staff can assist parents with locating items after camp. We cannot guarantee the return of every item. For information about items left behind please email Lauren at lauren@campranchoframasa.org.

Pick up for "found" items left at camp can be arranged during normal business hours, Monday-Friday, at the CYO office in Indianapolis or at the camp office. Unclaimed items are donated 2 weeks after each session. Camp is closed on Saturday. We ask parents to not "drop in" for lost and found. Sometimes items are taken home mistakenly by other families and we are unable to locate them at camp. We will connect families when possible.

Early Pickup?

To pick up your child early, contact Mae, Camp Registrar, at ext. 122 to make arrangements. Camp policy: Early pickups may only occur after 9:30 am, Monday-Friday and before 7pm, Monday-Thursday.
