Staying Safe

In response to the coronavirus we will be doing things a little differently this summer. Our goal is simple, it is to keep campers and families safe. Cancellation Policy

If your cancellation occurs more than 3 weeks before your camp session, then all fees are refundable, less an administrative charge of \$75 for summer camp. If your cancellation occurs less than three weeks before your camp session, then all fees are non-refundable. Refunds are not available for participants who leave camp due to homesickness, behavior or health reasons.

Full refunds will be made should we cancel programs for any reason.

About Our Fees

Why do our programs have 3 fees listed? Realizing that families have differing abilities to pay, we've instituted a VOLUNTARY 3-tier pricing program. Please take a moment to look at the fee descriptions below, and determine which of these three prices your family is able and willing to pay. This is strictly voluntary. In no way will the amount paid influence the quality of the experience children receive. As always, financial assistance is available.

Fee A: This is based on the actual cost of camp for a child to participate. Includes expenses for staff, maintenance, food, programs, supplies, and wear and tear/depreciation.

Fee B: This is our partially subsidized rate for those who can pay a little more but are still unable to afford the actual cost of camp.

Fee C: This is our standard subsidized fee.

Military Discount: Camp Rancho Framasa offers a reduced rate for the direct dependents of deployed service members. To receive this discount please complete the campership/scholarship form on the registration page.
