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RENTAL POLICIES

Welcome to your Camp Rancho Framasa experience! There are many things we can all do to create a successful visit for everyone. Below you will find camp policies. AS THE RENTAL LEADER YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING AND SHARING POLICIES WITH ALL GROUP MEMBERS. Please read thoroughly.

By signing your rental agreement, you commit to complete compliance and responsibility with all camp policies, including COVID-19 Safety Guidelines (below) for yourself and all those in your group. Policy violations may result in fines and possible dismissal from camp.

Check- In

- Check-in begins at 3:00 pm and closes at 9:00 pm.
- If your party is arriving after check-in hours, please contact us to arrange a morning check-in time.

Check-Out

- Check-out is 12:00 pm.
- If your party has not vacated the site by noon, a late fee of \$25 per person will be charged.

Visitors and Intruders

- Any person at camp that is not Camp Staff, or a member of a group is deemed a visitor.
- Visitors are allowed between 7:00 am and 11:00 pm; they must park in the main parking lot and complete a visitor slip.
- Any site that exceeds overnight occupancies will be charged for the extra people.
- If a person is deemed an intruder, Camp Staff will ask the person to leave.

Supervision

- Supervision of minors within your group is always the responsibility of parents or guardians.
- Campers are liable for any damages caused by children that are not supervised.

Quiet Hours and Privacy

- Quiet hours are from 11:00PM to 7:00AM. During these hours, please restrict noise to a reasonably quiet level to avoid disturbing others.
- Camp Staff live on camp; please respect their privacy and private residences.
- Our neighbors live near many the campsites and we need to respect them.
- Anyone creating a disturbance, is a nuisance to others, or deliberately breaks any of the rules and regulations, may be evicted from the property without notice and without refund.
- Please be respectful of others.

Facilities and Grounds

- Campers should only enter the spaces they have rented.
- Writing, painting, or otherwise marking on walls and floors is prohibited.
- You are asked to leave spaces in a neat and orderly manner. Please ensure all trash is in trash containers, remove all personal belongings, turn off lights, and close doors when vacating your rented space.
- Notify Camp Staff of urgent maintenance needs.
- Do not wash dishes in any of the bathrooms.
- The following areas are off limits to participants unless supervised by Camp Staff: High Ropes course, Sonrisa Low Challenge Course, Circuit course, barn/horse pasture, pool, lake, and any locked building.
- Please respect "no trespassing" signs and know camp's property lines. A camp map will be provided.

Recreation Areas

- The basketball court, volleyball court, tree house with slide, gaga pit, pavilion, and campfire circle are open between the hours of 8:00 am to 9:00 pm.
- Please be respectful of those camping near the recreation areas.

Natural Areas

- Take care not to collect items from the forest at Camp or harm any plants or wildlife.
- Stay on established trails and roads when moving around camp.
- Swimming is not allowed in the lake at any time.
- Littering at camp is prohibited. Use proper recycling and trash containers to dispose of refuse.
- Climbing trees is prohibited.
- There is an abundance of wildlife at camp. Your group may encounter deer, raccoons, opossum, squirrels, foxes, birds, and other wildlife. Please treat nature with respect and kindness.

Fires

- Fires may be built only in designated fire circles/fireplaces.
- DO NOT burn plastic, glass, or garbage in fire rings.
- Camp Staff will require unsafe fires or fires made in non-designated areas be extinguished immediately.
- Please use firewood from camp woodpiles in moderation. Camp will supply a limited amount of firewood for car camping and RV sites; primitive sites must find and use wood around the campsite. Please alert Camp Staff if assistance is needed.
- Do not leave your fire unattended. Coals or ashes should be cold any time you leave your site.
- Wood is not to be brought in from outside of Camp Rancho Framasa camp property.

Cars and Traffic

- Your group is limited to a certain number of vehicles per rented area.
- All other vehicles may be parked in the overflow parking area near the camp office.
- Vehicles must display the camp ID tag in the window when parked at a site.
- Cars should limit the amount of driving through camp property primarily using cars to come and go.
- Parking at or near the bridge's entryway, on the shoulder of Clay Lick Road, or anywhere in non-designated parking areas is prohibited.

Pets

- Pets must always be kept on a leash. There is a limit of 2 dogs per site.
- Pets are not to be tied outside of your RV when you are not at the campsite and are not to be left unattended at any time. Ground tie-downs are permitted
- It is expected that pets are picked up after and all waste is disposed of properly.
- If any pet demonstrates aggressive behavior toward another pet or person, you will be asked to leave the campground.
- Pets are not permitted in bathrooms.
- Pets must be on no more than a 6' leash, and under owners' control always.
- Excessive barking is prohibited and may result in you being asked to leave the campsite.

Smoking and Tobacco

- Smoking is permitted solely at your campsite or at a minimum of 40 feet from other patrons outside of your party.
- Cigarette butts and tobacco products should be disposed of properly.
- Smoking or use of any tobacco product including e-cigarettes, by minors, is not permitted at any time.
- All activity areas and camp buildings, including the Pavilion are SMOKE FREE.

Alcohol and Drugs

- Alcohol is permitted solely at your individual site, cabin, or house.
- Illegal drug use, and underage alcohol use is strictly forbidden at camp. Individuals using or in possession of illegal drugs, will be removed from camp property and appropriate legal action will be taken.

Flammables and Firearms

- Firearms, ammunition, air soft guns, paintball guns, and BB guns are not permitted on camp property.
- Hunting is not permitted on camp property.
- Fireworks are strictly prohibited.

First Aid and Emergency Care

- Rental groups are responsible for all first aid needs.
- Camp Staff may administer first aid to their trained ability as warranted.
- The rental group will be responsible for providing medical transportation to the injured party.
- Brown County emergency medical services (911) can be utilized for emergency transportation requiring an ambulance. If an ambulance is called, please inform camp staff so that we may assist in the direction of the first responders.
- Report any serious accident or injury occurring on camp property during your visit to Camp Staff.

Please keep these rental policies for future reference.

COMING TO CAMP?

We want you to feel safe at CYO Camp. We are committed to providing high levels of safety and disinfection during the COVID-19 pandemic while monitoring guidelines from the American Camp Association, the Indiana State Dept. of Health and the CDC. Although we cannot create a completely sterile environment our facility is prepared so that all who visit will remain as safe as possible.

OUR STAFF WILL:

- Receive and implement ongoing training on COVID-19 and disinfection protocols.
- Self-screen for COVID-19 daily.
- Not attend work if ill.
- Adhere to frequent hand washing for 20 seconds with soap and water or utilize hand sanitizer.
- Wear masks when inside.
- Social distance at least six feet apart when outside.
- Report COVID-19 cases and notify guests of confirmed cases.

WE ASK OUR GUESTS TO:

- Bring a mask to wear while inside any buildings.
- Allow screening for elevated temperature via an electronic non-contact thermometer prior to each visit.
- Wash hands frequently and for 20 seconds while at camp. Utilize hand sanitizer when soap and water aren't available.
- Allow social distance of at least six feet from others.
- Not attend camp if ill.
- Notify us of confirmed cases of COVID-19 at camp.
